## **Mayor is willing to revisit proposals for Chiswick High Road**

Sadiq Khan has agreed to revisit proposals for a segregated cycle superhighway through Chiswick High Road after scrutiny from London Assembly member Tony Arbour.

Under plans for the CS9 Cycle Superhighway, a segregated lane will be built where the route passes through high roads, including that in Chiswick.

However, Mr Arbour argued that Chiswick High Road is more akin to a high street, which emphasises the environment for shops, shoppers and access, and therefore the proposals would be wholly unacceptable.

At Mayor's Question Time on Thursday, the Mayor agreed to revisit the proposals and carry out a site visit to the area either personally or via a representative.

**Keen cyclist Mr Arbour, who rides to his local train station every day, said:** "Chiswick High Road is the beating heart of W4 and the existing proposals would kill the goose which lays the golden eggs.

"I am confident that Chiswick residents will now be assured that their views, and those of their councillors, will be taken into account before any final decisions are made."
